Associate Professor, School of Engineering  
**Tommie Awards**

The School of Engineering at UBC Okanagan has received a number of Tommie Awards for work that Dr. Alam has been involved with in the Wilden project. Tommie awards are presented by the Canadian Home Builders Association, Okanagan chapter to celebrate achievements in the building and construction industry. UBC Okanagan's School of Engineering was awarded the FortisBC award for Building Energy Efficiency, Excellence in Outdoor Living Space and Best Environmental Initiative in Construction.

The Wilden project is a collaborative three-year learning and research project by Wilden developer Blenk Development Corp., AuthenTech Homes, Geotility, UBC Okanagan, Okanagan College, FortisBC and Honeywell. The collaborative research is being conducted by UBC Professor Shahria Alam and Wilden to compare energy efficient technologies purpose-built into Wilden homes. This work and these awards highlight the collaborative partnerships and research in the community.

Dr. Alam is involved with research related to smart materials and their structural applications, and performance-based design of reinforced concrete. He holds a PhD in Civil Engineering from the University of Western Ontario and a MSc and BSc from Bangladesh University of Engineering & Technology.



## Mary Jung



Assistant Professor, Faculty of Health and Social Development  
**UBCO Health Researcher of the Year**

Dr. Jung has been recognized by UBC Okanagan for excellence in health research. The UBCO Health Researcher of the Year award recognizes faculty members at UBC Okanagan who have made significant contributions to research in the Tri-Council area of health and is presented at Celebrate Research week.

Her primary research focus is on self-regulatory behaviour change strategies to promote health behaviours such as weight loss or quitting smoking. Her research helps develop skills for individuals with type 2 diabetes and other chronic health problems. She also focuses on health program evaluation and health technologies.

Dr. Jung directs the Health and Exercise Psychology Laboratory for the School of Exercise Sciences and is valued for her motivation and her ability to inspire others.

Dr. Jung has an impressive list of accomplishments including Michael Smith Foundation for Health Research Scholar in 2014. She received her Post-doctoral Fellowship from Western University; PhD from University of Saskatchewan; and MSc and H.B.Kin from McMaster University
