Congratulations to Dr. Ayesha S. Chaudhry, who was named a 2018 Fellow by the Pierre Elliot Trudeau Foundation. This award highlights the important work Dr. Chaudhry is conducting with the Feminist Shari'a project, developing a narrative for a gender-equal Islamic law by engaging in policy and public conversations.

Dr. Chaudhry's research focuses on Islamic legal and theological reform, with an eye towards promoting human rights by focusing on women's rights. She is deeply committed to bridging the academic and civil society divide, which is mutually edifying. In service of this commitment, she is actively engaged in civic discourse around religion. Dr. Chaudhry has consulted on high-level national and international cases concerning human rights and religious pluralism and freedom. She works with NGO and international development organizations to improve women's rights and promote pluralism.

Dr. Chaudhry is the Canada Research Chair in Religion and Law. She was the 2015-16 Rita E. Hauser fellow at Radcliffe Institute for Advanced Study at Harvard University and the 2016-17 Wall Scholar at the Peter Wall Institute for Advanced Studies at UBC. This year, she was inducted as a Member of the College of New Scholars, Artists and Scientists of the Royal Society of Canada.

Professor Savvakis Nicolaou completed his medical degree at the University of Toronto and residency in Diagnostic Radiology at UBC. In the Faculty of Medicine, Dr. Nicolaou helped integrate radiology into the medical curriculum. He is the Vice-Chair of undergraduate education and continuous professional development in the Radiology Department. He is investigating ways to develop faster, safer, and more sensitive methods for diagnosing patients in the acute care setting.

The Prix d'excellence Specialist of the Year award recognizes Fellows of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons who have made significant contributions in providing outstanding care to their patients and the community. Dr. Nicolaou was also previously recognized with a Prix d'Excellence Mentor of the Year Award from the College in 2013, as well as a UBC Killam Teaching Prize the same year. Dr. Nicolaou's enormous contributions to Emergency radiology will be recognized by the American Society of Emergency Radiology, making him the first Canadian Fellow of the Society.

Professor Nicolaou has been actively involved in teaching medical students, residents, and fellows and has served as a mentor for many of them. He is one of Canada's most experienced educators in Emergency Radiology, and his lectures locally, nationally and internationally accordingly reflect his dedication, expertise and outstanding collaborative skills.

Dr. Webb received her PhD in Education from UBC. She spent a decade as a classroom teacher and department head before returning to higher education as a teacher educator.

Her research interests are in teaching and learning in higher education, specifically research projects related to Threshold Concepts, the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning, and Social Studies Teacher Education. She believes that the role of an educator is to help learners equip themselves with the skills to make intelligent, reasoned decisions, whether that be in the classroom or in their own research. She is on the program advisory board for the International Program for the Scholarship of Educational Leadership (SoEL) and the Board of the SoTL Canada special interest group. Dr. Webb is a recipient of the Higher Education Academy's prestigious recognition of excellence in educational leadership and teaching at the university level – Senior Fellowship. She has previously received the Faculty of Education Sessional and Lecturer Teaching Award and AMS Just Desserts.
