**Prix Robert Roy Award
Canadian Association of Second Language Teachers**

A leader in French education, Dr. Wendy Carr recently served a term as Associate Dean of Teacher Education in the Faculty of Education. Since beginning her career as an educator in the public school system over 30 years ago, she has gone on to develop new education programs, conduct groundbreaking research on language education methodology, and prepare educators to inspire French learning in Canadian classrooms. She is a recognized champion of second language education.

The Prix Robert Roy recognizes individuals whose efforts have advanced, in an extraordinary manner, the field of second language education. The announcement of Dr. Carr's award cited her "influence in shaping second language teaching and learning in Canada through teaching French, defining research in language education methodology and providing leadership in local, provincial, national and international organizations."

Dr. Carr has received several other awards for her work. In 2008, she received the Faculty of Education Excellence in Teaching Award and more recently the Murray Elliot Award for Outstanding Contribution to the Teacher Education Program. In 2018, she was named Teacher Educator of the Year by the Association of BC Deans of Education.

Congratulations to Dr. Sarah Gergel, who was named a 2018 Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS). The AAAS bestows this lifetime honor in recognition of extraordinary achievements in advancing science. Dr. Gergel is recognized for her work to greatly improve our understanding of the implications of human impact on ecological processes at the land-water interface.

Dr. Gergel's research focuses on spatial ecology, resilience and ecosystem services, with an emphasis on developing novel yet rigorous geomatics approaches to understanding pressing environmental problems. Currently, her projects span across a diverse range of ecosystem types, from forests to rivers and grasslands to coral reefs, comparing and contrasting remote sensing and local ecological knowledge.

Dr. Gergel completed her Ph.D. at the University of Wisconsin and her Post-Doctorate at the University of California. She joined UBC in 2003.

Killam Award for Excellence in Mentoring

The Killam Awards for Excellence in Mentoring are presented to two UBC faculty members per year in recognition of outstanding mentorship of numerous graduate students over many years. Professor Matei Ripeanu has received the mid-career award for 2018. Professor Ripeanu's approach to mentoring is very much catered to the needs of his students. One of his students explains: "One aspect that stands out concerning Professor Ripeanu's mentoring approach is his adaptability. He deliberately adjusts it to each mentee – according to their particular traits, skill sets, motivations, circumstances and ambitions." Another student adds: "His mentoring style is to let the students' curiosity and interest be the driver of their own research journey."

Professor Ripeanu received his PhD degree in Computer Science from the University of Chicago in 2005. After a brief visiting period with Argonne National Laboratory, he joined the Electrical and Computer Engineering Department at UBC. He is broadly interested in experimental parallel and distributed systems research with a focus on massively parallel accelerators, data analytics, and storage systems.

Professor Ripeanu co-leads the NetSysLab (Networked Systems Laboratory) whose mission is to explore the computing infrastructure of the future. The infrastructure will enable collaborative secure resource sharing and deliver predictable performance at moderate cost.
