Canada Gairdner Wightman Award The Gairdner Foundation

Congratulations to Dr. Connie Eaves, who is the recipient of the 2019 Canada Gairdner Wightman Award. This award honours scientists for their transformative contributions to research that impact human health. Dr. Eaves is being recognized for her pioneering work and leadership in the study of hematopoietic, mammary and cancer stem cells, as well as for her dedicated advocacy for early-career investigators and women in science.

Dr. Eaves is recognized as one of the most creative and accomplished biomedical scientists advancing solutions to problems facing humanity around the world. Her research has focused on leukemia and breast cancer and the normal tissues in which these diseases originate. Throughout Dr. Eaves' distinguished career, she has demonstrated outstanding national and international leadership. She co-founded the Terry Fox Laboratory at the BC Cancer Agency, was a leader in the Canadian Stem Cell Network and held multiple senior roles in the National Cancer Institute of Canada.

After completing her B.A. in Biology and Chemistry and an M.Sc. in Biology (Genetics) from Queen's University, she then pursued doctoral training and obtained a Ph.D. from the University of Manchester in the United Kingdom. Dr. Eaves was elected a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada (1994), received the Robert L. Noble Prize for Excellence in Cancer Research from the National Cancer Institute of Canada (2003), and in May 2019, Dr. Eaves was inducted into the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame.

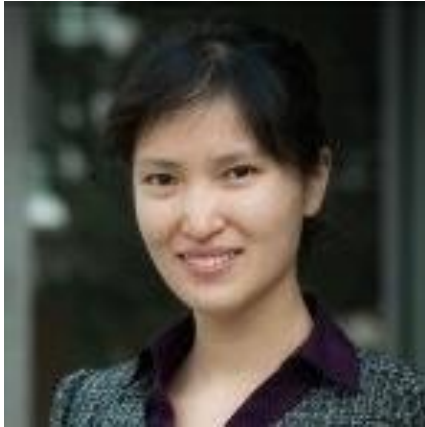

Dr. Leo Stocco received his PhD degree from UBC in the field of robotics and control in 2000. He went on to lead the Robotics Group at Integrated Surgical Systems which builds a surgical robot for total hip and knee arthroplasty surgery. In 2005, he returned to UBC as a faculty member where his research interests include gear drive systems, biomedical devices, and haptic interfaces.

Dr. Stocco is listed in the UBC Experts Guide as an authority on such topics as robotics, haptic interfaces, human computer interfaces, and 3D printing. He is often called upon to speak to the media and was most recently quoted in the Vancouver Sun regarding computers and robotics in the workplace. He is a co-founder and inventor of Orbitless, a revolutionary high efficiency gearbox technology platform.

The Wighton Fellowship is a national award to recognize excellence in the development and teaching of laboratory-based courses in Canadian undergraduate engineering programs. The Fellowship has been awarded every year since its inception in 1987 at universities across Canada. This is not the first recognition that Dr. Stocco has received for his exemplary teaching; in 2012 he was awarded the UBC Killam Teaching Prize, the most prestigious teaching award at UBC.

Prior to joining UBC in January 2013, Dr. Siyun Wang was a postdoctoral associate at Cornell University. She received her BSc in Pharmacy from Fudan University in 2005 and PhD in Biology from Illinois Institute of Technology (2010). In her current role as Associate Professor of Food Safety Engineering, she conducts research on microbial safety in the Ulrich Freybe Food Safety Laboratory. She also heads the Wang Lab of Molecular Food Safety.

Dr. Wang's research focuses on understanding how foodborne pathogens like *E. coli* and *Salmonella* survive in food and cause disease in humans. As a UBC Expert in food safety and foodborne disease, she was recently quoted in the CBC Marketplace story, "Testing Shrimp for Superbugs". She is currently leading a suite of federally and provincially funded projects aimed at reducing antibiotic-resistant bacterial pathogens in agriculture using bacteriophages.

The Food Safety Award was given to Dr. Wang by the BC Food Protection Association, an affiliate of the International Association for Food Protection which has over 4,000 members in 50 nations. This diverse organization plays a pivotal role in global food safety.

The medal recognizes those who have "brought high honour to the School ... [having] significantly advanced the School's vision, mission and mandate." This award reflects nearly 25 years of collaborative psychometric and statistical research with professors of nursing, and significant contributions to the training of advanced nursing and health researchers.
