EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In accordance with UBC Board of Governor’s Policy 128, the Board receives an annual report about the “Deaccession of Works of Art and/or Cultural Materials for the Morris and Helen Belkin Art Gallery, the University Library, and the Museum of Anthropology”.

At its June 2018 meeting, the Board of Governors approved the repatriation of the Haida mortuary pole (MOA A50017) from the collection of the Museum of Anthropology (MOA) to the Haida Repatriation Committee, as authorized by the Haida Nation. MOA is currently working with the Haida Repatriation Committee to set a date for the repatriation of the pole. The Haida Repatriation Committee is also repatriating two poles from the City of Vancouver that are housed at the Museum of Vancouver, and the current plan is to repatriate the three mortuary poles at the same time. The date for formal transfer has not yet been set but current discussions are considering dates in July 2019.

No other art works and/or cultural materials from the University’s collection were recommended for deaccession by repatriation for the period May 1, 2018 to April 30, 2019.
