

**DESCRIPTION &
RATIONALE**

The Naming Committee may recommend that a facility be named to reflect its use, to honour someone associated with the University, or to recognize a donor.

On, July 25, 2019, the Naming Committee recommended approval of University Boulevard Lot as a Class 1 Facility name for the underground parking lot between the AMS Student Nest and the UBC Exchange at 6131 University Boulevard under the new MacInnes Field. The name appropriately associates the parking lot with the University Boulevard Neighbourhood which it serves. The term “lot” is used to differentiate this one level structure from the multi-level parkades around campus. The name reflects the structure’s function and location on campus and is in accordance with Naming Policy 124.

The Naming Committee considered the naming request and resolved to recommend the proposed name, University Boulevard Lot, to the President for referral to the Board of Governors for approval.
