New Awards

Organization of the University

That the Board of Governors concur with the recommendation of Senate in approving the following:

The name of the School of Library, Archival and Information Studies (SLAIS) be changed to the School of Information (abbreviated as “iSchool”), as set out in the attached proposal, effective 1 January 2020;

The name of the School of Journalism, be changed to the School of Journalism, Writing, and Media, as set out in the attached proposal, effective 1 January 2020.
