EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

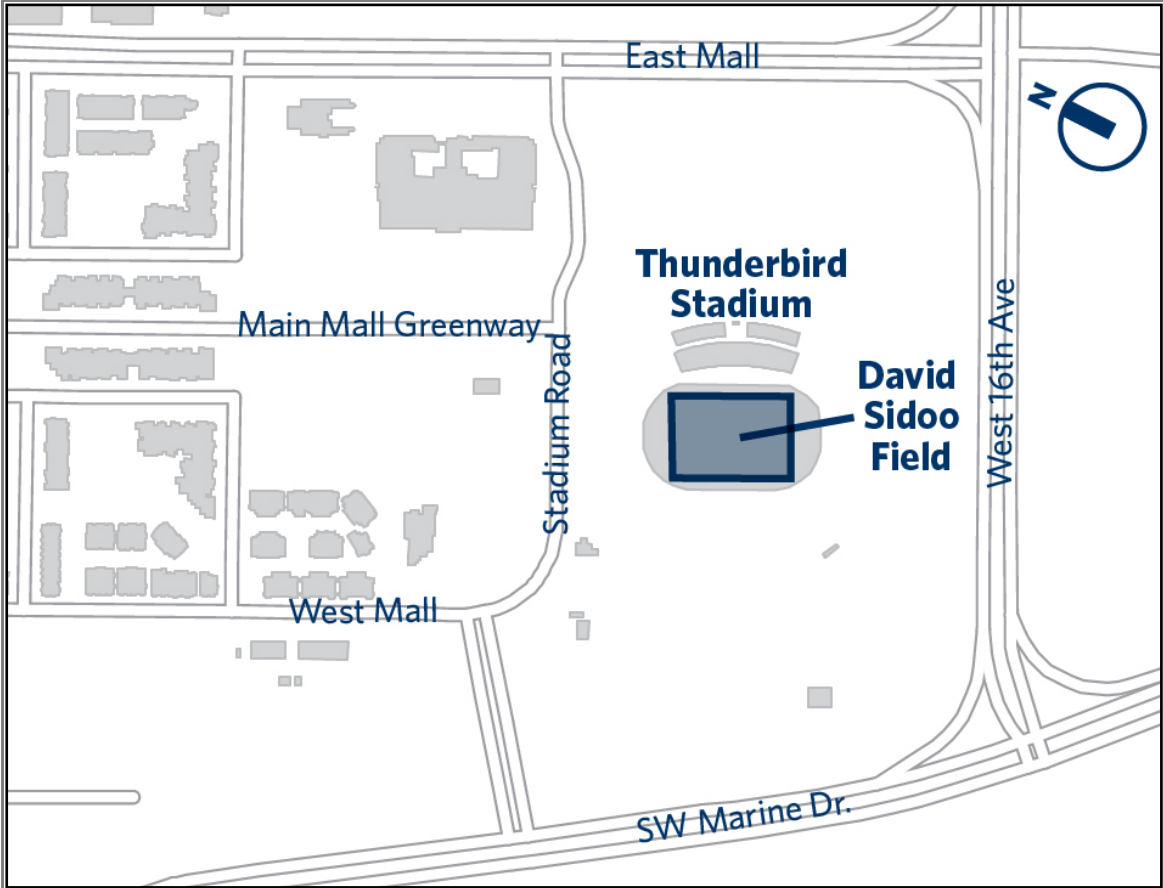
In 2011, Mr. Sidoo pledged support towards the enhancements of the Thunderbird Football Stadium that included new seating, a score clock, new field and upgraded Heritage Room. David Sidoo Field was named in recognition of his pledged gift of \$600,000. Naming approval was provided by UBC in 2012.

On March 11th, 2020, Mr. David Sidoo, sent correspondence to the University requesting the removal of his name from the UBC Athletics Stadium playing field (David Sidoo Field).

At the March 12, 2020 meeting of the Naming Committee the request to remove the name was approved and it was recommended that the President refer their recommendations to the Board of Governors for approval.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

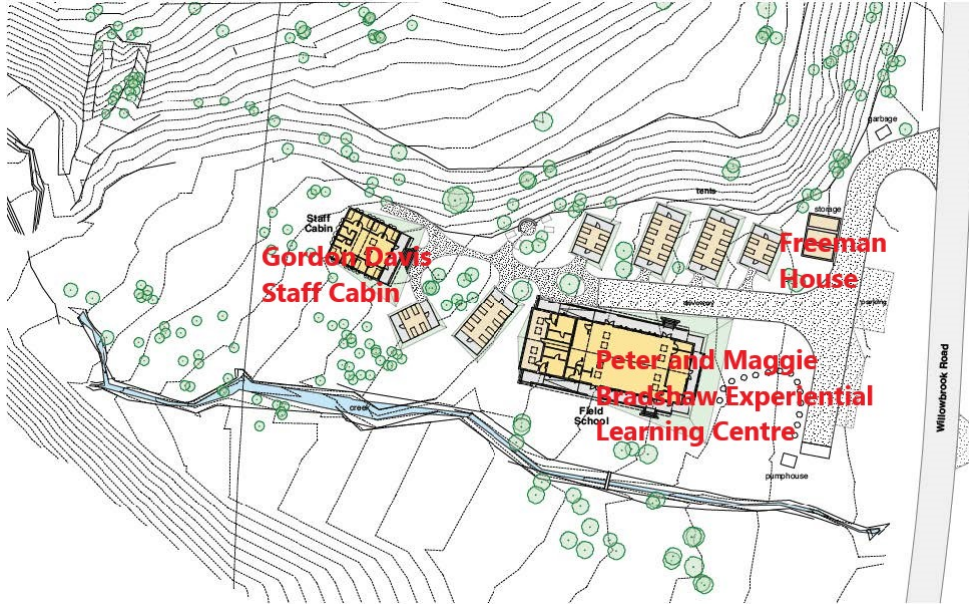
Board of Governors' Policy #GA6 'Naming' establishes policies and procedures for approving names for campus facilities. The President forwards Class 1 facility naming recommendations from the Naming Committee to the Board of Governors for approval. This report conveys the recommendations of the March 12, 2020 meeting of the Naming Committee for Board.

The Naming Committee may recommend that a facility be named to reflect its use, to honour someone associated with the University, or to recognize a donor.

On March 12, 2020, the Naming Committee considered the following Class 1 Facilities requested by the Development office as recognition of a donor:

- a) **Freeman House** - the caretaker home at the Geological Field Station operated by the Department of Earth, Ocean and Atmospheric Sciences in Oliver.
- b) **Gordon Davis Staff Cabin** - the main staff accommodation building at the Geological Field Station operated by the Department of Earth, Ocean and Atmospheric Sciences in Oliver.
- c) **Peter and Maggie Bradshaw Experiential Learning Centre** - the main multipurpose building including dining facilities at the Geological Field Station operated by the Department of Earth, Ocean and Atmospheric Sciences in Oliver.
- d) **MacInnes Family Field**, A new artificial turf field on the site of the original Aquatic Centre replacing the original MacInnes Field.
