# Paul Cubbon

## **3M National Teaching Fellowship 2020**

Paul Cubbon joins nine other honourees from across Canada, including UBC's Tiffany Potter, in receiving a prestigious 3M National Teaching Fellowship, the highest recognition of individual teaching excellence and educational leadership in Canada. "Paul has been the key driving force in the creation of a university-wide curriculum for entrepreneurship education at UBC," says Robert Helsley, Dean of the Sauder School of Business. "This curriculum includes courses that support venture creation and bring together the skills and perspectives of students in different disciplines ... for the purpose of starting new enterprises."

Cubbon completed a BA (Honours) with a major in Geography at Oxford University, and subsequently an MBA at Simon Fraser University, where he taught before joining UBC, initially part-time in 2001 and then full-time in 2005. Cubbon's interests are in marketing communication, customer behaviour, innovation and competition, social media, and how these combine to influence management practice for organizations to be truly customer serving. His current focus is to support scientists to commercialize their discoveries for positive societal impact. Having recently assumed the role of Assistant Dean, Innovation, Cubbon already serves as Leader and Academic Director of Creative Destruction Lab West, a seed-stage program for massively scalable, science and technology-based companies, and as Leader of the Innovation & Entrepreneurship Group at UBC Sauder, teaching actively in both the undergraduate and graduate programs. Cubbon has received several other awards as an educator, including the Sauder School's "Talking Stick" for pedagogical innovation (2011), The CGA Graduate Teaching Award (2013) and the Killam Undergraduate Teaching Award (2016).



# Catherine Dauvergne

Congratulations to Professor Catherine Dauvergne, who was honoured with the Queen's Counsel (QC) title by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, on the recommendation of the Attorney General. The QC designation is the most prestigious form of recognition for members of the legal profession and is recognized in Commonwealth jurisdictions around the world. Professor Dauvergne is acknowledged for her leading voice in immigration and refugee law, an area she has worked in for over 25 years.

Much of Professor Dauvergne's work engages feminist critique of the law, and the place of women in immigration, refugee, and citizenship laws. Dauvergne is currently a research collaborator on the SSHRC funded project *Finding a Place for Rights: An Independent Evaluation of the Impact of the Beyond the Border Initiative on Human Rights at the Canada-US Border*.

Catherine Dauvergne studied law at UBC and completed her PhD at the Australian National University. She was a member of the Faculty of Law at the University of Sydney for four years before returning to Canada. From 2002 to 2012, Dr. Dauvergne held the Canada Research Chair in Migration Law at UBC, and is now the eighth dean of the Peter A. Allard School of Law. In 2012, Professor Dauvergne was elected as a Fellow by the Pierre Elliott Trudeau Foundation.



# Deborah Money

## **Red Ribbon Award, AIDS Vancouver**

Professor Deborah Money has been honoured with a Red Ribbon Award from AIDS Vancouver in recognition of her work and impact on HIV prevention and care. She has been a longstanding advocate for persons living with HIV and their need for ongoing research and optimal care.

Dr. Money earned a BSc in Microbiology and an MD at UBC, followed by her residency in Obstetrics and Gynecology, also at UBC. She completed a clinical and research Fellowship in Infectious Diseases at the University of Washington and returned to UBC as the first individual in Canada with this combined training.

Dr. Money has developed a translational research program in Reproductive Infectious Diseases focused on HIV in pregnancy, human papilloma virus, and the prevention of cervical cancer. She is also actively involved in teaching at the undergraduate, postgraduate and continuing medical education levels, and established the first fellowship in Infectious Diseases for Obstetrician/ Gynecologists in Canada.

She was awarded the Society of Obstetrics and Gynecology Western Regional Award for Achievement (2013), the YWCA Women of Distinction Award (2013), and the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal (2012), the Women's Health Research Institute Career Award for Excellence in Research (2017) and the Infectious Diseases Society of Obstetrics & Gynecology Lifetime Achievement award in 2019.
