# Susan Herrington

## **UBC Killam Faculty Research Prize in the Arts and Humanities Senior Scholar Category**

Congratulations to Professor Susan Herrington, who was honoured with the UBC Killam Faculty Research Prize in Arts & Humanities, Senior Category, in recognition of her outstanding research and scholarly contributions.

Professor Herrington's research focuses on design theories of contemporary landscape architecture. She regularly teaches histories of landscape architecture, theories in landscape architecture, vertical studios, and core studios. She leads studios that investigate contested landscapes, including landscapes for risk, and seminars that explore the competing ideas underpinning modernism versus postmodernism.

Susan has held a professorship at UBC for almost 22 years. She is currently the newsletter editor of the Society of Architectural Historians Landscape History Chapter, and she served as Chapter president from 2011 to 2013.

## 2020 In Her Footsteps Award Sport BC

Professor Patricia Vertinsky has been honored with an *In Her Footsteps* Award from Sport BC, presented to women who have had a significant impact in support of women and girls in sport, and who have strengthened the community through their passion, academic expertise and commitment. Dr. Vertinsky's story will be presented and profiled in the *In Her Footsteps* exhibit at the BC Sports Hall of Fame.

Professor Vertinsky is a social and cultural historian of physical culture exploring the world of fitness, sport, physical activity and physical education across the last two centuries and in a transnational context. She is regarded as among the most influential thinkers through her critiques of gender, race, age and opportunity in sport and physical activity and has received numerous honors and awards, including an honorary doctorate from the University of Copenhagen; elected Fellow of the American Academy of Kinesiology; Killam Research Prize; Distinguished Scholar in Residence at the Peter Wall Institute for Advanced Studies; Past-President of the North American Society for Sport History and Vice-President of the International Society for the History of Sport.

Professor Vertinsky has served UBC in multiple ways as Distinguished University Scholar, Associate Dean, Department Head and research professor through her innovative teaching and extensive list of research publications while extending her wide ranging scholarship locally, nationally and internationally.



# HsingChi von Bergmann

## 2021 UBC Killam Teaching Prize

Professor HsingChi von Bergmann has received UBC's most prestigious teaching honour, the Killam Teaching Prize. She has received this award for her transformative impact on teaching and learning at an institutional, disciplinary, and societal level.

Professor von Bergmann completed a Ph.D. in Curriculum & Instruction focusing on Science Education at the University of Southern California. She started conducting research in Problem-Based Learning in dental education while at USC in 1997. In 2003, von Bergmann became a Professor in the Faculty of Education at the University of Calgary. In Fall 2010, she became an Education Specialist at the UBC Faculty of Dentistry to (1) conduct and mentor educational research activities in the Faculty, and (2) design modules and professional development activities to enhance teaching capacity and students' educational experiences. Since arriving at UBC, she has obtained 50 grants to support her colleagues' development in educational scholarship.

In 2016, Prof. von Bergmann received a competitive and prestigious dental education fellowship, the ADEA/ADEA Gies Foundation Education Fellowship. She has been invited to give nearly 65 speeches and lectures (12 of which are keynote speeches) nationally and internationally. She has co-written a book on international comparative education, various book chapters, and published widely in peer-reviewed journals.
