Hi Ainsley,

I hope you are doing well! I am writing from the VP Finance Office at the AMS of UBC Vancouver. I wanted to notify you of a fee change we are proposing for the Engineering Undergraduate Society under the Faculty of Applied Sciences.

As of Sept 2021, the Engineering Student Centre (ESC) loan has been paid off completely- therefore, students do not need to be assessed the ESC fee as of 2021W. As well, the Engineering Without Borders (EWB) fee was not successfully approved in referendum for continued assessment. Therefore, we are proposing to completely remove the EWB fee as of 2021W.

I've attached the following fee breakdown below to illustrate the changes we are proposing.

EUS Fee Breakdown	Before	After

Engineering Student Centre	\$58.84	N/A
Engineering Without Borders	\$2	N/A
Engineering Design Teams Council	\$2	\$2
Total	\$107.26	\$46.42

Overall, we are proposing a decrease for the SLF-ENGR from \$107.26 to \$46.42.
