Hi Ainsley,

I hope you are doing well! I am writing from the VP Finance Office at the AMS of UBC Vancouver. I want to notify you of a new \$60.00 fee that has been approved to be charged to each UBC School of Nursing student (under the Nursing Undergraduate Society or Graduate Student Nursing Association) for the next 30 years. Fee collection is to start September 2022.

The Board of Governors of UBC in December 2019 approved the development of a new building on the Gateway site (the northwest corner of Wesbrook Mall and University Boulevard) for the School of Nursing, the School of Kinesiology, Student Integrated Health Services, and UBC Health. The School's areas of this new building will be designed specifically for nursing education and nursing research, including nursing-specific and interprofessional clinical education in a High Fidelity Simulation suite, and state-of-the-art large and small classrooms. The School of Nursing, in partnership with the Nursing Undergraduate Society (NUS) and the Graduate Student Nursing Association (GSNA) is proposing an annual student fee be assessed to help support the proposed new building, which is slated to be built over the next 3-5 years.

Overall, we are proposing a new \$60.00 fee to be assessed to students of the UBC School of Nursing for the purpose of funding the new Gateway building at the UBC Vancouver campus.
