At its meeting of January 25, 2022, the Board of Governors approved the establishment of the Advisory Committee on Campus Vision 2050 and Rapid Transit. This newly established Committee will provide advice and input to the Property Committee of the Board of Governors with regard to an integrated approach for Campus Vision 2050 and rapid transit planning.
