# Jeffrey Andrews

Associate Professor, Irving K. Barber Faculty of Science

**President, Classification Society**



Dr. Andrews was recently Elected the 2022-2023 President of the Classification Society, a nonprofit interdisciplinary and international organization focused on promoting the scientific study of classification and clustering and disseminating scientific and educational information. In addition to his role as President he also is a member of 4 other professional services/committees. Dr. Andrews also has numerous grants and awards.

As a teacher of statistics and data science, Dr. Andrews leads students through methods to quantify information, draw useful conclusions and make accurate predictions. His research primarily investigates finite mixture models and their usage in statistical machine learning. His focus is on clustering and classification, with peer-reviewed articles exploring parameter estimation, variable selection, and model development.

Dr. Andrews holds a PhD and a MSc from the University of Guelph. His BSc, with Honours, was earned from Acadia University.



# Abbas Milani

Dr. Milani received the UBC Okanagan Researcher of the Year award in 2015 and his accolades have continued to grow ever since. He received the Killam Research Fellowship in 2016 for his research in advanced composite materials and their manufacturing. Most recently, in 2020, Milani was named a new member of the College of New Scholars, Artists and Scientists.

Dr. Milani's study is in the area of multi-scale, modeling, simulation and optimization of engineering materials, structures and forming processes. His research has designed lighter and stronger materials for aerospace industry leaders such as Bombardier and Boeing. He is the Principal Investigator of the Okanagan Node of the Composites Research Network (CRN) and Advanced Materials and Fabrication Core Competency Lead of UBC's Survive and Thrive Applied Research (STAR) program. Dr. Milani is also the Director of the recently established Materials and Manufacturing Research Institute at UBC in addition to the lead of the UBC Biocomposites Research Cluster.

Dr. Milani has a PhD in Mechanical Engineering from McGill University and a MSc and a BSc in Mechanical Engineering from Islamic University of Science and Technology. He has also completed postdoctoral work in Mechanical Engineering at MIT.
