## **Janice Forsyth**



Professor, School of Kinesiology Faculty of Education

### R. Tait McKenzie Lifetime Achievement Award Physical and Health Education Canada

Congratulations to Professor Janice Forsyth for receiving the R. Tait Lifetime Achievement Award. This award honours extraordinary and life-long dedication to the advancement of physical and health education in Canada. She received the award for her 20+ year commitment to advancing Indigenous health and well-being in Canada through research and service in the sport, physical activity, and physical education sectors.

Prof. Forsyth joined UBC's School of Kinesiology in 2022. Her research combines history and sociology to explore the relationship between sport and culture in Canada from Indigenous perspectives. Previously, she received the 2012 Premier's Research Excellence Award for Ontario, and in 2019 she was elected to the College of the Royal Society of Canada. Several of her publications were cited in the 2015 final reports of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada.

A member of the Fisher River Cree Nation, Prof. Forsyth is Vice-President of the Aboriginal Sport Circle, a national organization that provides advocacy and support for Indigenous-led sport development, and is President of the Ontario Physical and Health Education Association, the subject association for physical and health education in the province, reaching 2.1M youth through 72 school boards and 4,934 schools annually.



## **Michael Lee**

### 3M National Teaching Fellowship Award Society for Teaching and Learning in Higher Education

Congratulations to Professor Michael Lee for being awarded a 3M National Teaching Fellowship from the STLHE. This prestigious award, bestowed annually to ten outstanding Canadian educators, recognizes Professor Lee's exceptional contributions to teaching and learning at UBC, nationwide, and internationally.

"Education is about more than acquiring knowledge and skills, but also about shaping hopes and passions," said Lee. "This award recognizes the importance of teaching to the heart. The ultimate goal for a healthcare educator is to transform a student into a skilled clinician with a heart to foster recovery." His vision is to continue to advance teaching and wellbeing beyond Canada, North America, and to the rest of the world.

Prof. Lee has received numerous other awards for his contributions to teaching and service. These include the Psychosocial Rehabilitation Canada's Ambassador Award in 2015, UBC's Margaret Fulton Student Development Award in 2018, and, in 2021, the Killam Teaching Prize, UBC's highest honour for teaching.



## **Suzanne Simard**



Professor, Forest and Conservation Sciences Faculty of Forestry

### Kew International Medal, Kew Royal Botanical Gardens Lewis Thomas Prize, The Rockefeller University

Congratulations to Professor Suzanne Simard who was awarded the Kew International Medal by The Royal Botanical Gardens, Kew which recognizes an individual whose work ensures that plants and fungi are understood, valued, and conserved. Dr. Simard was also awarded The Rockefeller University Lewis Thomas Prize for Writing about Science which honours "the scientist as poet".

Dr. Simard's research is motivated by her desire for protecting our fundamental right to a clean and healthy environment. Her research focuses on the synergies and complexities of our natural world and the development of sustainable land stewardship practices that both conserve and protect the environment. Dr. Simard has published more than 200 scientific peer-reviewed articles and has earned a global reputation for leading research on tree connectivity and communication. In 2021 she published *Finding the Mother Tree,* a *New York Times* bestseller that draws parallels between humans and trees and highlights interdependence and mutual support in forest ecosystems.

Dr. Simard holds a BSF in Forest Resource Management from UBC, and a PhD and MSc in Forest Ecology from Oregon State University.
