EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In June 2023, the Finance Committee was advised that documentation of Board approval could not be located for a total of 96 student fees across both campuses. The Administration brought forward all 96 fees, including 29 fees that the Administration had determined would no longer be collected, to the November 2023 meeting of the Finance Committee, at which the Committee, under its delegated authority, ratified and approved for collection on a going-forward basis the 67 remaining fees for which documentation of previous Board approval could not be located.

After approval was confirmed, and as the Administration was preparing the necessary information so that fees could be added to the student system and to the UBC Calendar, a data-entry error was identified. Unfortunately, a field trip fee from the Faculty of Forestry was inadvertently approved at the incorrect rate. UFOR 400 is an undergraduate course required by all students in the Bachelor of Urban Forestry.

The Administration is seeking to rectify this error and ensure the field trip fee is approved at the appropriate rate.
