6. Tuition for New Program Bachelor of Science, Major in Data Science	APPROVAL REQUESTED IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that, in accordance with authority delegated by the Board of Governors, the Finance Committee approves tuition for the Bachelor of Science, Major in Data Science of \$202.64 per credit for domestic students and \$1,701.35 per credit for international students, subject to increases as approved by the Board of Governors, to remain consistent with tuition rates for the Bachelor of Science leading up to the program's launch in September 2025.

Repeal of International Tuition Rate APPROVAL REQUESTED **Exemption for Selected International** IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Finance Committee recommends that the Students Board of Governors approve the following, applicable to students on the Vancouver and Okanagan campuses: i. effective May 01, 2025, new incoming students who are in Canada with a full-time long-term work permit or are the dependant or the spouse of an individual who is in Canada with a full-time long-term work permit will no longer be exempted from international tuition rates; and, ii. students enrolled prior to May 01, 2025 and who were deemed eligible for exemption from international student tuition rates under the Work Permit category will maintain their exempted status for the standard length of their current degree program if they continue to meet the eligibility criteria for exemption under the Work Permit category as approved by the Board of Governors in 2019. 9.
