**Named Top 40 under 40 | Kelowna Chamber of Commerce**

Congratulations to Dr. Jeff Andrews who was named a Top 40 under 40 by the Kelowna Chamber of Commerce. The program recognizes and honours individuals in the community who take leadership, philanthropy and business to the next level.

In addition to being an associate professor, Dr. Andrews is the principal co-director of the Master of Data Science and the lead researcher of the Statistical Machine Learning Laboratory, established with funding from the Canada Foundation for Innovation and has since attracted over \$4.2 million in research funding.

In his time as the co-director of the Master of Data Science, enrolment has increased by nearly 30% and his student researchers have gone on to study at internationally renowned universities like Stanford, Columbia and the University of Toronto. Dr. Andrews has contributed significantly to the community through various volunteer positions such as on the Brachytherapy Chair Research Advisory Board for the BC Cancer Centre for the Southern Interior, as well as serving as a panel reviewer for the Degree Quality Assurance Board and as a committee member for the Statistical Society of Canada.

Dr. Andrews earned his BSc from Acadia and his MSc and PhD from the University of Guelph.

## **Killam Teaching Prize, UBC Okanagan**

Congratulations to Dr. Bowen Hui, recent recipient of the 2025 UBC Okanagan Killam Teaching Prize. The Killam Scholarship and Prize Programmes were established in 1965 by Izaak Walton Killam and Dorothy J. Killam. As one of the six Killam institutions, UBC offers the annual Killam Teaching Prize to faculty in recognition of excellence in teaching.

Dr. Hui is known for her personalized approach to learning that empowers students to take ownership of their education. She builds inclusive learning environments that celebrate diverse perspectives and support equity, diversity and inclusion inside and outside the classroom to help all students thrive. She recently led the development of a Faculty-wide peer student mentoring program, designed to increase students' sense of belonging and identity within their discipline, Faculty and the university. Dr. Hui has received numerous recognitions for her teaching in recent years, including the Open Education Excellence and Impact Award (2024), the Computer Science Canada Excellence in Teaching Award (2023) and the Provost's Award for Teaching Excellence and Innovation (2022).

Dr. Hui earned her MSc and PhD in Computer Science from the University of Toronto, and a BSc in Computer Science and Linguistics from the University of British Columbia.

## **Balsillie Prize for Public Policy**

Congratulations to Professor Wendy H. Wong, whose book *We, the Data: Human Rights in the Digital Age* won the 2024 Balsillie Prize for Public Policy from the Writers' Trust of Canada. This annual prize celebrates a book of nonfiction that advances and influences policy debates on a wide range of social, political, economic or cultural topics relevant to Canadians.

Dr. Wong is a Professor of Political Science at UBC Okanagan, where she explores the effects of an increasingly digital and data-intensive world on human rights and dignity. As Principal's Research Chair in Datafication (Tier 1), Dr. Wong raises questions about the digital data sourced from humans that makes AI technologies possible. Her work aims to help people better understand the implications of AI, including its inherent human biases. She calls for government and technology creators to be aware of—and responsive to—the potential harms of both AI and increasing digital data. The 2024 Balsillie Prize for Public Policy jury praised *We, the Data* as “a highly compelling and original book about the risks to society when the drive to collect data outpaces our capacity to contain it, and how to fix it before it is too late.”

Dr. Wong was the 2024 Researcher of the Year in Social Sciences and Humanities and co-leads UBCO's Digital Transparency Research Excellence Cluster.
